- *television watching

To share the responsibility for improved student achievement.

To communicate with our child/children's teachers about their educational needs.

To ask parents and parent groups to provide information to the school on what type of training or assistance they would like and/or need to help them to be more effective in assisting their child/children in the educational process.

To ensure that all students come to school fully prepared, each and every day.

The student will: Do their homework every day and ask for help when it is needed. Read at least 30 minutes every night. Give all notices and information to their parents.
